RESPONSIBILITIES

Working under the general supervision of the Manager of Primary Care and as a member of an interdisciplinary team, the Nurse Practitioner is responsible for:

- Ordering appropriate screening and diagnostic tests and interpreting test results.
- Determining and prescribing treatments based on evidence-informed practice.
- Documenting clinical care accurately and appropriately.
- Applying pharmacology principles when selecting and prescribing drugs.
- Coordinating and facilitating care by liaising with other healthcare providers, organizations and community resources.
- Providing counselling and education services to clients and their families.
- Participating in the professional development of nurses and other health professionals and supervising the activities of nursing student interns.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- Master of Nursing Degree, Nurse Practitioner Program Degree or equivalent educational qualifications as approved by the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba (Category of practice: NP family / all ages).
- Advanced nursing care knowledge related to health assessment, diagnostic, pharmacotherapeutics, invasive and minor surgical procedures.
- Knowledge of health promotion, community development and program evaluation concepts.
- Ability to work in a computerized environment.
- Have an excellent knowledge of French and English, both oral and written.
- Cardiopulmonary training for family and friends.
